Do not wait until the last moment to make an appointment. The physical must be paid for at the time of the appointment. No insurance will be filed except for those who have health insurance coverage under Medical Assistance. If you are not certain if your athlete needs a physical, please contact Beth Decker at Antigo High School (715) 623-7611 ext 2100 or email her at bdecker@antigoschools.org Please turn in any physical forms to Beth Decker as soon as you have the physical done. Any questions regarding the physicals should be directed to the Aspirus General Clinic or the Antigo Medical Building. Athletes under the Age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent.
